## Professional

### Career Highlights

- In 1999, made the field at the State Farm Rail Classic as the seventh and final alternate and went on to tie for fourth, her best finish in seven years.
- In 1998, best finish was a tie for seventh at the Michelob Light Classic.
- In 1997, best finish was a tie for 15<sup>th</sup> at the Diet Dr Pepper National Pro-Am.
- In 1996, top finishes were a tie for seventh at the Rochester International and tie for ninth at the Youngstown-Warren LPGA Classic.
- In 1995, best finish was a tie for 12<sup>th</sup> at the Star Bank LPGA Classic.
- In 1994, tied for fifth at the State Farm Rail Classic; tied her career-low round of 65 during the SAFECO Classic.
- In 1993, best finish was a tie for 11<sup>th</sup> at the Youngstown-Warren LPGA Classic; tied her career-low round of 65 during the second round of the SAFECO Classic, where she tied for 12<sup>th</sup>.
- In 1992, posted her career-best finish at the Lady Keystone Open, where she tied for second.
- In 1990, best finish was a tie for 11<sup>th</sup> at the Phar-Mor in Youngstown; recorded her second career ace at the Stratton Mountain LPGA Classic.
- In 1989, best finish was a tie for eighth at the USX Golf Classic, where she fired her LPGA career-low round of 65 during the first round.
- In 1988, top finish was a tie for 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Lady Keystone Open.
- In 1987, top finish was a tie for 20<sup>th</sup> at the Boston Five Classic.
- In 1986, best finish was a tie for 11<sup>th</sup> at the Konica San Jose Classic; recorded the first hole-in-one of her career at the S&H Golf Classic.
- In 1979, turned professional and gained valuable experience by playing the Tampa Bay, Women Professional Golfers' European Tour (WPGET) and Women's Florida mini-tours.

## Amateur

West, who did not start playing golf until 1978 at the age of 22, was runner-up at the 1979 Colorado State Amateur. She played in four amateur events that season prior to turning professional.

## Major Championship History

The U.S. Women's Open became an LPGA major in 1950; the McDonald's LPGA Championship Presented by AIG became a major in 1955; the Kraft Nabisco Championship became a major in 1983; and the Weetabix Women's British Open became a major championship in 2001. From 1979-2000 the LPGA's fourth major was the du Maurier Classic. The Weetabix Women's British Open replaced the du Maurier Classic in 2001.
